Sixth grade students are responsible for keeping up with their own daily materials. They will not keep materials in the desk, supplies will be carried in their backpack when changing rooms.

### REQUIRED MATERIALS

#### **Classroom supplies to bring to Open House**

4-pack of glue sticks  
cleaning wipes (Lysol or Clorox)  
cap erasers  
3-pack paper towels  
1 small bottle of hand soap  
3-pack Scotch tape  
4-pack dry erase markers  
3 boxes of tissues  
1 ream copy paper  
1 pack of notebook paper

#### **Each student needs in their book bag:**

flash drive on a lanyard  
one 8-pack of colored pencils  
one 8-pack fine-point washable markers  
school agenda  
wooden pencils or clicker pencils  
cap erasers  
zippered pencil pouch  
one hard plastic duotang folder with three prongs and pockets  
4-pack highlighters

#### **Items to keep at home:**

pack of poster board  
extra packs of notebook paper  
extra packs of pencils and pens

Please do not bring zipper binders. Each binder must fit into the book bag.

one 1-inch binder

one 1-inch binder

one hard plastic 3-hole punch folder w/ 2 pockets

#### **Mrs. Beck: Math, Social Studies**

8 subject dividers  
three ½-inch binders, used one at a time  
one 2-inch binder (math)
